### Registration/Payment Policy:

While space exists, parents may register at the church office. \$50 is payable before your Child's Camp week. If it is necessary to withdraw your child please try to give us 2 weeks notice. A refund of \$25 will be mailed to you.

### Arrival/Departure of Campers:

Gateway Day Camp Staff is on duty from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. Please arrive at Camp by 9:00 am. If you are picking up your child(ren prior to 4:00 pm please note this in the sign-in book in the morning. Please drive cautiously in the Gateway Parking area. Campers will only be permitted to leave Gateway with a person who has been authorized by you, the parent, AND is named on the Camper registration form. Please be advised that we will ask for a picture identification.

### Guidance and Discipline (Camper):

We do not anticipate that there will be behavior difficulties with the Campers, as they are all kept very busy. In a situation where a child does become unmanageable, the staff is trained to use acceptable methods of re-directing [changing the activity/location] and level discussion [away from the group but within sight, at the child's level]. Should there be repeated episodes of unmanageable behavior so as to compromise the child, other children, or the program, you will be notified to pick up your child as soon as possible. Subsequently, a conference will be held, if possible within 24 hours., with you, the Program Director and the Child's Leader, to work out an acceptable strategy.

### Safety/Health:

We strive at Gateway to maintain the highest standards of health and safety for the Campers. Should a camper experience an accident or illness that we are unable or unqualified to deal with, we will transport him/her to the Emergency Department at Victoria General Hospital [10 minutes away] and/or call you, the Parent/Guardian as soon as is expedient. Staff is not permitted to administer over the counter medication without precise, written instruction from the Camper's Doctor, and the medication supplied in a clearly marked original medicine container. Please do not send any medication with your child to administer to him/herself. All medicines will be kept in a locked container in the Kitchen.

### General:

Gateway Baptist Church cannot be held responsible for items missing at the site or while away on fieldtrips. The program at Gateway involves some community visits away from the Church. Campers will be driven in the Gateway van, bus or staff vehicles. On occasion photographs or video is taken of the Campers in activities. These are used for promotional purposes.

### Informed Consent:

At Gateway we will strive to take every precaution to ensure the safety and well-being of each camper. But even with normal activities, such as outdoor games, sports, daytrips to various locations, and transportation, there are certain risks involved. In consideration of Gateway Baptist Church sponsoring or being involved with various functions with the Participant during the Summer Day Camp, the undersigned parents / guardians and participant hereby:

- A) acknowledge that involvement in and access to some or all of these activities may involve private and / or public transportation; understand that these activities and transportation to and from them may involve some risks; the undersigned accepts full risk and responsibility for the death of or injury to the participant or damage to the property of the participant arising from the functions or transportation of the participant to and from such functions.
- B) give permission for my child to participate in all activities and I understand and accept these potential risks and as the undersigned, am bound hereby to release forever the Gateway Baptist Camp and all the individuals associated therewith, from any and all liability for injury or damage (including but not limited to bee or hornet stings or any other insect bites, injuries from sports, games & water activities) which may be sustained by the undersigned and/or child of the undersigned or property of the same at or in transit to, at or from any camp conducted activity or under auspices of Gateway Baptist Church.
- C) release and forever discharge the Gateway Baptist Church, its members, directors, officers, leaders, agents and employees from all actions, causes of action, suits, claims and demands whatsoever, that may arise from any activities or transportation to and from them, however caused.
- D) indemnify and hold harmless the Gateway Baptist Church, its members, directors, officers, leaders, agents and employees from any actions, suits, claims, demands whatsoever, arising from any negligent, wrongful or illegal act or omission of the participant in respect of any function or transportation sponsored, arranged or coordinated by the Church or its agents.
- E) give permission for my child/ren to have their photographs taken for sole use of Gateway's Day Camp including multi-media, DVD/CD, Gateway's Web Page: gatewaybaptistchurch@shaw.ca, and future brochures.

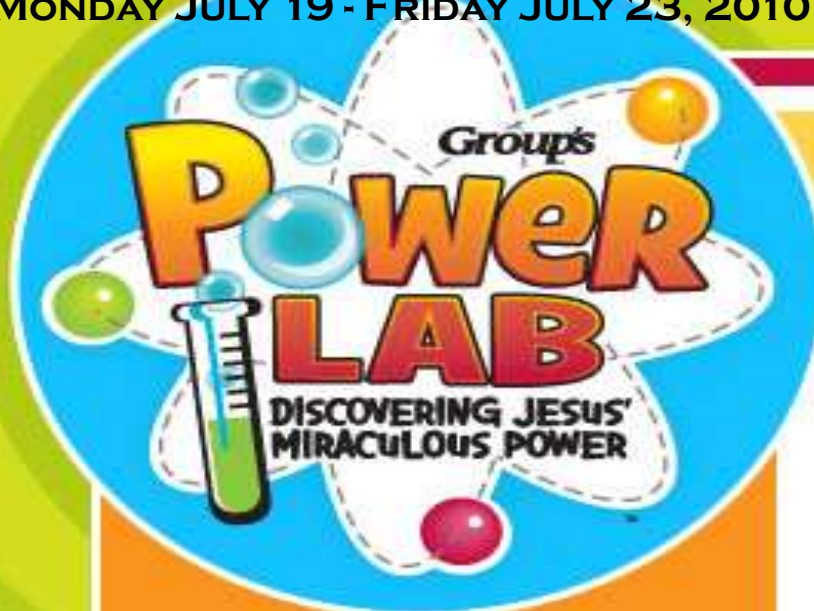

## **GATEWAY BAPTIST DAY CAMP: MONDAY JULY 19 - FRIDAY JULY 23, 2010**

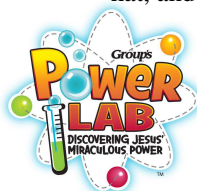


- Open to ages K - Grade Five.
